Exhibition

Drawing from numerous private and museum collections, a variety of table settings celebrates the designers and manufacturers of the middle twentieth-century who utilized their talents to design and mass produce dinnerware with an innate understanding of form and function.

The wide selection of ceramic and plastic dinnerware, glassware, utensils, and serving pieces includes those designed by Russel Wright and Edith Heath in an exhibition of the material culture of an era when the "cult of dining" took on a new meaning.

Mid-Century to Modern: Dinnerware by Russell Wright and Heath Ceramics explores the ways in which table settings were often influenced by fashion-driven color and pattern trends, new materials and manufacturing technologies, and shifts in our cultural identity in post-World War II society.

Supplementing the dinnerware, glassware, and flatware will be contextual objects such as vintage linens, furnishings, contemporary advertisements, fashion items, and a range of ephemera including product catalogues, party invitations, and etiquette guides.

Mid-Century to Modern: Dinnerware by Russell Wright and Heath Ceramics will also serve as an influence to the theme of the Frank Lloyd Wright's Price Tower annual Gala fundraiser, held at the Bartlesville Community Center on the evening of January 30, 2016.
